Handbook Highlight:

When a child contracts a communicable, contagious disease, the Health Department advises treatment by a doctor and requires that the child remain at home during the acute stage of infection. A student who had contracted said disease must bring a note stating that the child's doctor has approved the return to school. *After an illness, the student should be fever, rash, vomit, and diarrhea free without medication for 24 hours before returning to class. If a child is absent for 3 or more days, they must have a Dr. note to return.*
